Job Description

The Maintenance Mechanic will work directly with, and report to, the company's Maintenance Foreman and Maintenance Manager. The Maintenance Mechanic is responsible for monitoring, maintaining, servicing, repairing, rebuilding and moving industrial machinery in an abrasives manufacturing plant to ensure a safe and effective production environment. Machines include, but are not limited to, conveyors, bucket elevators, sifting/grading machines, crushing machines, dust collection systems and industrial magnetic separators. This position is Monday-Friday 7am-3:30pm and 3 Saturdays per month 7am-12pm.

Essential Functions

- Responsible for the overall performance of equipment and vehicles and routine maintenance as assigned
- Inspect, diagnose and perform necessary repairs of defective or worn components of crushers, graders, mills, dust collectors, rotary kilns, hoists, cranes, conveyors, baggers and other industrial machinery
- Preventative maintenance and routine repairs of all buildings and equipment contained within
- Conduct basic plumbing repairs
- Conduct basic carpentry repairs
- Snow Removal
- Other maintenance duties as assigned
