Job Description

Reporting to the Department Supervisor, the Production Worker is accountable for continuous product throughput, will inform management of the results from the production unit's operations, pointing out problem area and advising on the best alternative to follow in order to achieve acceptable productivity and quality levels. Works with other operators in production unit and is required to perform various packaging, cleaning, sampling and material transfer tasks. It may be necessary to move to different positions, as production demands.

Dimensions

Strives for zero defect and optimum unit throughput. Coordinates efforts with Supervisor to meet departmental budget.

Specific Accountability

1. Packages materials in containers to customer specifications.
2. Transports material as necessary with lift truck or pallet mover.
3. May be required to stencil containers.
4. Takes testing samples and operates quality monitoring equipment.
5. Completes documents and reports as necessary.
6. Does machinery adjustment and setup.
7. Responsible for unit area cleanup with manual or power equipment.
8. Keeps low lifts clean.
9. Tapes pipes.
10. Tightens roll crushers on weekends.
11. Adheres to Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) for the respective production unit assigned to.
12. Runs power sweeper as requested by Management.
13. Goes to other departments on off shifts to obtain material as needed.
14. May go to other departments to obtain material as needed.
