Job Description

The Production Material Handler – (Redkote/Silkote) will work directly with, and report to, the company's Production Foreman and Production Lead. The RK/SK operator will be directly involved in the monitoring and operation of several pieces of crushing and grading equipment as well as a gas-fired rotary kiln, producing chemical mixtures using a chart. This position will be responsible for working harmoniously and safely within a team environment as well as independently. This position is currently scheduled 48 hours per week Monday–Thursday 6pm-6am with occasional Fridays.

Essential Functions

- Fill, transport, palletize, stack, and organize drums, super sacks and bags of abrasive grain through various methods: manually, with powered lift devices, with motorized pallet jacks and with fork trucks
- Follow operating procedure for the mixer, kiln, conveyor, dumper and screener
- Prepare chemical mixtures with use of charts, following mixing formulation procedure
- Follow housekeeping procedures
- Perform other necessary duties and projects as assigned (ex. general servicing/tooling of production equipment, housekeeping and various preparatory tasks for production, general cleaning duties)
- Weigh, label and test abrasive grain
- Must be able to follow all prescribed safe work methods and work injury free
- Become cross-trained all areas of Production in Plant 1
- •Monitor the Redkote/Silkote process for evidence of mechanical failure, product contamination and other quality issues
- •Use/maintain Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) according to policy

- Excellent interpersonal skills including the ability to work as part of a team
- Ability to perform basic math calculations
